STATEMENT CYCLES & OPTIONS

- The Statement Cycle will determine when a customer's statement is generated, the format of the statement and their Autopay scheduled run date (if enrolled).
- Statements are mailed once a month to the customer's billing address. A customer may request their statement be sent to an alternate address.
- Customers also have the ability to choose between two different e-delivery channels to receive their statements rather than via mail.
 - Henry Schein e-Statements: Enrollment will notify a customer via email when their statement is available for viewing through their registered account on the Henry Schein website.
 - **Billtrust**: Enrollment allows the customer to receive the actual statement in a PDF format directly within an email.
- Invoice Pay customers are eligible for all statement cycles and formats. Statement Pay customers are limited to cycles which are not invoice-specific.
